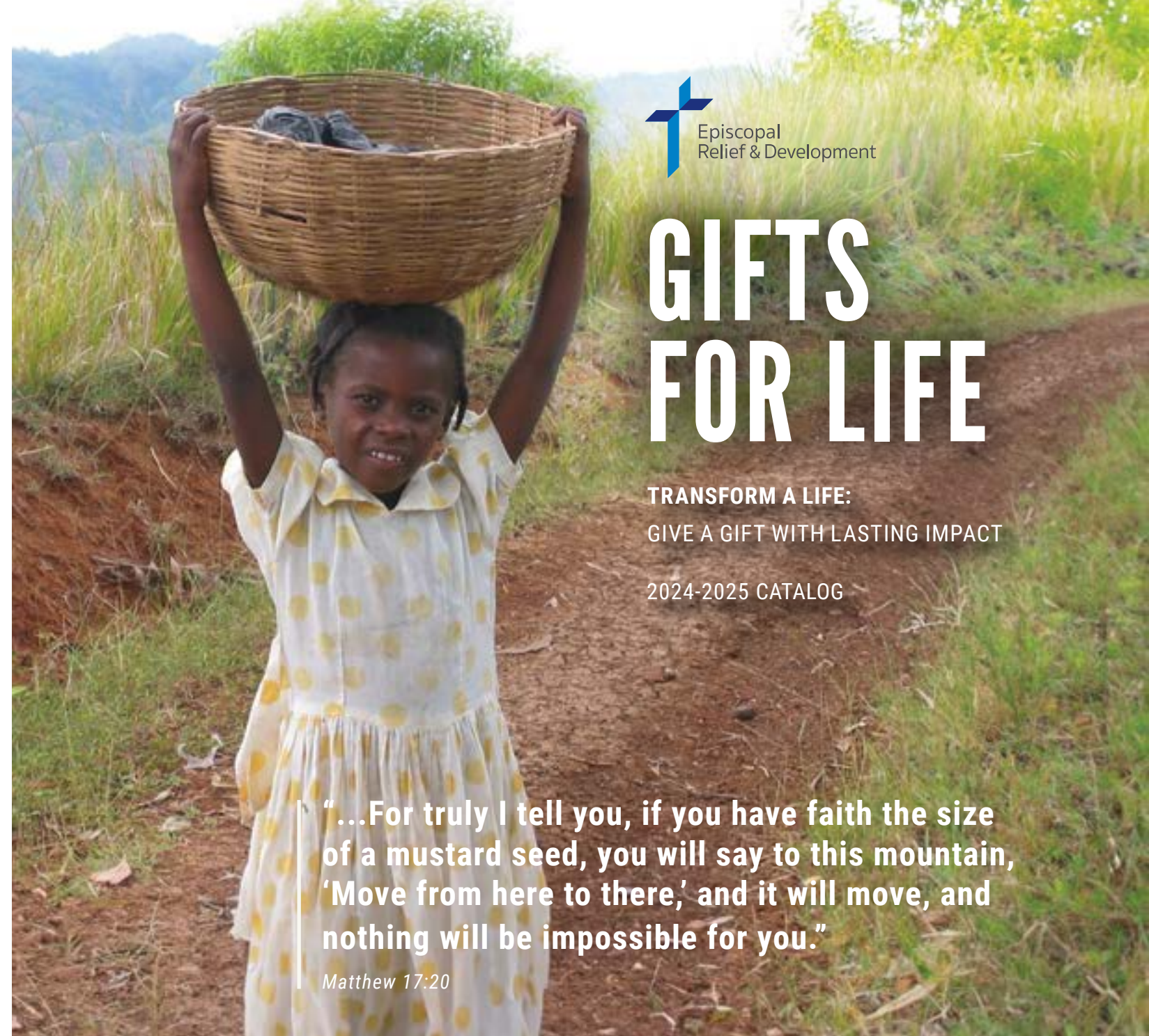

FLOCK OF CHICKENS

Animals are often at the center of investment and income generation. Empower families to make their own financial choices with a flock of chickens to raise additional poultry and sell surplus stock and eggs in the marketplace.

BEEHIVES

Bees pollinate field crops, which leads to increased food security and helps provide their keepers with a reliable source of income.

NURTURE & NOURISH THE EARLIEST LEARNERS

Help kids develop thinking, communication, social, emotional and motor skills through caregiver support and learning groups that promote healthy eating and family play.

Hearing aids, glasses and other assistive devices are life-changing to physically challenged children, giving them the opportunity to participate meaningfully in community life.

GIFTS IN ACTION

Harvesting Abundance in Nicaragua

Nora is an entrepreneur and family gardener from Somoto, Nicaragua. Her husband is away most of the year caring for his sick sister, leaving Nora to tend their garden on her own. Before connecting with our partner, the Council of Protestant Churches of Nicaragua (CEPAD), her harvests yielded next to nothing.

Then Nora received help with her **Family Garden**. She attended a series of training workshops and received a small micro-credit loan through CEPAD's Development Program for Women. Three years later, her garden is abundant. She now harvests papaya, tomato, pineapple, cucumber, cucurbit, radish, cilantro and much more.

With the money she's saved by growing her own food and selling a portion of her harvest, Nora is able to financially support herself while her husband is away. She's even been able to expand her business by purchasing a refrigerator to diversify the types of food she sells.

FINANCIAL LITERACY GROUPS

Help foster a woman's entrepreneurial spirit with training to improve her money management, analysis and decision-making practices, and build skills to support cost-effective business creation.

FAMILY GARDEN

Provide seeds, training and education for families to create low-cost, low-effort kitchen gardens that produce fresh fruits and vegetables they can use to increase the nutritional value of meals and generate income by selling surpluses.

Help communities build wells for clean water and learn hygiene practices for better health. Locally available water also gives women and girls greater security, because they won't be at risk while walking long distances to fetch water.

Empower women as they learn how to set up and run their own groups and use their savings as revolving capital for microloans to meet their families' needs and invest in themselves.
